To set up systems whereby Jews, Muslims, Hindus, Buddhists and even atheists feel left out and unwanted is a mockery of our Constitution, which clearly provides religious freedom for every American." - Barbara Lautman

She is incorrect in this last statement!

Except for quoting Arthur Clarke, he is incorrect in the entirety of his statement!

The "hijacking of morality by religion" did not occur, but the opposite did! Morality has been hijacked by the atheists who claim it with no basis for what is moral!

It is much like a Muslim coming to the US and swearing to uphold the Constitution while holding to the Koran.

Qur'an (4:89) - "... therefore take not to yourselves friends of them, until they emigrate in the way of God; then, if they turn their backs, take them, and slay them wherever you find them; take not to yourselves any one of them as friend or helper." After hitting a high in 1990 of 1.8-4.3 times the 1960 rate, the rates in Violent crime, Property, Murder, Rape, Robbery, assault, and Burglary are down to about 0.9-2.3 times the rate in 1960 on a per capita basis.

There are 218 verses in the NT containing the word "good" in the KJV and 217 in the ESV

I found one for me especially, 1Ti 4:6 If you put these things before the brothers, you will be a good servant of Christ Jesus, being trained in the words of the faith and of the good doctrine that you have followed.

I found some especially for the ladies if they are to be ladies cared for by the church.

1Ti 5:10 and having a reputation for good works: if she has brought up children, has shown hospitality, has washed the feet of the saints, has cared for the afflicted, and has devoted herself to every good work. 1Ti 2:9-10 likewise also that women should adorn themselves in respectable apparel, with modesty and self-control, not with braided hair and gold or pearls or costly attire, (10) but with what is proper for women who profess godliness with good works.

I found something for all of us as we are all rich in this country.

1Ti 6:17-19 As for the rich in this present age, charge them not to be haughty, nor to set their hopes on the uncertainty of riches, but on God, who richly provides us with everything to enjoy. (18) They are to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous and ready to share, (19) thus storing up treasure for themselves as a good foundation for the future, so that they may take hold of that which is truly life.

Eph 2:10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

What are these good works?

Eph 2:15-19 by abolishing the law of commandments expressed in ordinances, that he might create in himself one new man in place of the two, so making peace, (16) and might reconcile us both to God in one body through the cross, thereby killing the hostility. (17) And he came and preached peace to you who were far off and peace to those who were near. (18) For through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father. (19) So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God

Php 2:12-13 Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, so now, not only as in my presence but much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, (13) for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure.

Col 1:10-12 so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God. (11) May you be strengthened with all power, according to his glorious might, for all endurance and patience with joy, (12) giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in light.

Preaching the word of God to those who are lost is primary among the "good" that the Scriptures teach us.

What is the key for restoring the place that righteousness had in this nation?

Luk 8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God.

Luk 8:15-18 As for that in the good soil, they are those who, hearing the word, hold it fast in an honest and good heart, and bear fruit with patience. ... (18) Take care then how you hear, for to the one who has, more will be given, and from the one who has not, even what he thinks that he has will be taken away."

2Pe 3:9-12 The Lord is ... patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance. (10) But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, and then the heavens will pass away with a roar, and the heavenly bodies will be burned up and dissolved, and the earth and the works that are done on it will be exposed. (11) Since all these things are thus to be dissolved, what sort of people ought you to be in lives of holiness and godliness, (12) waiting for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be set on fire and dissolved, and the heavenly bodies will melt as they burn!

If you haven't lived a "good" life, turn to Jesus and join in the battle to return Jesus to the place He should have in the hearts of those around us.
