There are those who come among us and find our simple services dry and sterile. There's no beautiful building or organ music that fills the space.

There are some of our children who are made to attend when they don't want to be here and they say, "it's boring!" After all, there's no band; no rock guitar; not even a piano to entertain us.

We're just all about studying our Bibles.

And then we turn to our songbooks. #345 A song that cannot fail to move us! It Is Well With My Soul

## Where does our emotion in worship come from?

Certainly not from listening to a lesson from the word of God from a man speaking from the pulpit -- at least not usually until the invitation.

Then, sometimes I see tears in the eyes of some.

**#31 Almost Persuaded** 

"Almost Persuaded" is a sad song when someone is thinking about being baptized for the remission of their sins but can't quite make the move. It pulls at their heart to make that decision that will bring them into Christ

But think about the love that's in the song as we try to encourage our loved ones to make the move that will give them eternal life.

At other times we speak of those who have gone before – and scattered around the building I see men and women who remember loved ones gone to their reward and times gone by when they rejoiced in their youth as well as in their old age – and I see tears.

The Lord directs us all to sing and speak to one another – no choirs, no bands, but each one of us singing to the Lord and to our brethren! Because of the light God shines on us through His word, which is buried deep within our hearts as the assembly lifts their voices together, we must be so careful that our songs are based on the Scriptures.

## Nearer Still Nearer #436

Many years ago, a good friend who had been attending with us said, "I like your services, but must you always sing those dreadful songs at the end of the service?

If you think an invitation song is worthless, let me point out that you never know who is in the crowd and even a visitor who complains about our invitation songs, heard the words and they did as they should – they distressed him!
