

Heb 2:1 Therefore we must pay much closer attention to what we have heard, lest we drift away from it.

What we have heard - that delivered by Jesus which is superior to prophets and angels and new revelation is superior to the old.

It is possible to drift away

2Ti 2:15 Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth.

*Heb 2:2 For since the message declared by
angels proved to be reliable, and every
transgression or disobedience received a just
retribution,*

Gal 3:19 Why then the law? It was added
because of transgressions, until the offspring
should come to whom the promise had been
made, and it was put in place through angels
by an intermediary.

Heb 2:3 how shall we escape if we neglect such a great salvation? It was declared at first by the Lord, and it was attested to us by those who heard,

Mat 1:21 She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins."

Evidence that Paul was not the author.

Gal 1:11-12 For I would have you know, brothers, that the gospel that was preached by me is not man's gospel. (12) For I did not receive it from any man, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation of Jesus Christ.

Heb 2:4 while God also bore witness by signs and wonders and various miracles and by gifts of the Holy Spirit distributed according to his will.

Mar 16:20 And they went out and preached everywhere, while the Lord worked with them and confirmed the message by accompanying signs.

Act 14:3 So they remained for a long time, speaking boldly for the Lord, who bore witness to the word of his grace, granting signs and wonders to be done by their hands.

Heb 2:5 For it was not to angels that God subjected the world to come, of which we are speaking.

Dan 2:44 And in the days of those kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom that shall never be destroyed, nor shall the kingdom be left to another people. It shall break in pieces all these kingdoms and bring them to an end, and it shall stand forever,

*Heb 2:6 It has been testified somewhere,
"What is man, that you are mindful of him, or
the son of man, that you care for him?"*

Quote of Ps 8.4

Rev 17:14 They will make war on the Lamb,
and the Lamb will conquer them, for he is
Lord of lords and King of kings, and those
with him are called and chosen and faithful."

*Heb 2:7 You made him for a little while
lower than the angels; you have crowned
him with glory and honor,*

Php 2:6-7 who, though he was in the
form of God, did not count equality with
God a thing to be grasped, (7) but
emptied himself, by taking the form of a
servant, being born in the likeness of
men.

Heb 2:8 putting everything in subjection under his feet." Now in putting everything in subjection to him, he left nothing outside his control. At present, we do not yet see everything in subjection to him.

Act 2:33 Being therefore exalted at the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, he has poured out this that you yourselves are seeing and hearing. 34 For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he himself says, "'The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at my right hand, (35) until I make your enemies your footstool."'

Heb 2:9 But we see him who for a little while was made lower than the angels, namely Jesus, crowned with glory and honor because of the suffering of death, so that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone.

Heb 10:12 But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God,

Heb 2:10 For it was fitting that he, for whom and by whom all things exist, in bringing many sons to glory, should make the founder of their salvation perfect through suffering.

Said of the Father to make Jesus a perfect high priest

Heb 4:15 For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin.

Heb 2:11 For he who sanctifies and those who are sanctified all have one source. That is why he is not ashamed to call them brothers,

Joh 17:17 Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth.

Mat 12:50 For whoever does the will of my Father in heaven is my brother and sister and mother."

*Heb 2:12 saying, "I will tell of your
name to my brothers; in the midst of
the congregation I will sing your
praise."*

A quote of Ps 22.22

Heb 2:13 And again, "I will put my trust in him." And again, "Behold, I and the children God has given me."

A quote based on Ps 91:2 and Isa 12:2

Isa 8:18 Behold, I and the children whom the LORD has given me are signs and portents in Israel from the LORD of hosts, who dwells on Mount Zion.

Heb 2:14 Since therefore the children share in flesh and blood, he himself likewise partook of the same things, that through death he might destroy the one who has the power of death, that is, the devil, he too shared in their humanity - NIV

1Co 15:54 When the perishable has been clothed with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality, then the saying that is written will come true: "Death has been swallowed up in victory."

*Heb 2:15 and deliver all those who
through fear of death were subject to
lifelong slavery.*

Rom 7:24-25 Wretched man that I am!
Who will deliver me from this body of
death? (25) Thanks be to God through
Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, I myself
serve the law of God with my mind, but
with my flesh I serve the law of sin.

*Heb 2:16 For surely it is not angels that he helps, but he helps the offspring of Abraham.
(ESV)*

Heb 2:16 For verily he took not on *him* the nature of angels; but he took on *him* the seed of Abraham. (KJV)

¹⁶ For indeed He does not give aid to angels, but He does give aid to the seed of Abraham.
(NKJV)

Gen 12:3 And I will bless them that
bless thee, and curse him that
curseth thee: and in thee shall all
families of the earth be blessed.

Heb 2:17 Therefore he had to be made like his brothers in every respect, so that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.

ESV/ASV/NASV propitiation = KJV
reconciliation = atonement NIV
literally - the ransom price

Heb 2:18 For because he himself has suffered when tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted.

1Jn 2:16 For all that is in the world—the desires of the flesh and the desires of the eyes and pride of life—is not from the Father but is from the world.

Jesus was tempted as we are, but he was tempted by things tempting to Almighty God.

Mt 4:3 stones to bread - lust of flesh

Mt 4:6 cast down - pride of life

Mt 4:8 kingdoms - lust of eye
