

*1Jn 1:1 What was from the beginning,  
what we have heard, what we have seen  
with our eyes, what we beheld and our  
hands handled, concerning the Word of  
Life—*

Joh 1:1-2 In the beginning was the Word,  
and the Word was with God, and the  
Word was God. (2) He was in the  
beginning with God.

Act 1:2... apostles whom He had chosen. 3 To these He also presented Himself alive, after His suffering, by many convincing proofs, appearing to them over a period of forty days, and speaking of the things concerning the kingdom of God.

Luk 24:36 And while they were telling these things, He Himself stood in their midst. (37) But they were startled and frightened and thought that they were seeing a spirit.

(38) And He said to them, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? (39) "See My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself; touch Me and see, for a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have."41 ... , "Have you anything here to eat?" (42) And they gave Him a piece of a broiled fish; (43) and He took it and ate it before them. (44) Now He said to them, "These are My words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things which are written about Me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms must be fulfilled." (45) Then He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures,

Rev 19:11-13 And I saw heaven opened; and behold, a white horse, and He who sat upon it is called Faithful and True; and in righteousness He judges and wages war. (12) And His eyes are a flame of fire, and upon His head are many diadems; and He has a name written upon Him which no one knows except Himself. (13) And He is clothed with a robe dipped in blood; and His name is called The Word of God.

*1Jn 1:2 and the life was manifested, and  
we have seen and bear witness and  
proclaim to you the eternal life, which  
was with the Father and was manifested  
to us—*

Joh 1:14 And the Word became flesh,  
and dwelt among us, and we beheld His  
glory, glory as of the only begotten from  
the Father, full of grace and truth.

Joh 15:26-27 "When the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, *that is* the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, He will bear witness of Me, (27) and you *will* bear witness also, because you have been with Me from the beginning.

Joh 17:3 "And this is eternal life, that they may know Thee, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom Thou hast sent.

*1Jn 1:3 what we have seen and heard we proclaim to you also, that you also may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father, and with His Son Jesus Christ.*

Joh 17:20 "I do not ask in behalf of these alone, but for those also who believe in Me through their word;

Joh 20:30-31 Many other signs therefore Jesus also performed in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; (31) but these have been written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing you may have life in His name.

2841 - koinoneo 8 times - to share with  
others

2844 - koinonos 10 times - a sharer

Lk 5:10 partners in fishing vessel

*1Jn 1:4 And these things we write, so that our joy may be made complete.*

3Jn 1:3 For I was very glad when brethren came and bore witness to your truth, *that is*, how you are walking in truth. 4 I have no greater joy than this, to hear of my children walking in the truth.

*1Jn 1:5 And this is the message we have heard from Him and announce to you, that God is light, and in Him there is no darkness at all.*

**Psa 27:1 A Psalm of David.** The LORD is my light and my salvation; Whom shall I fear? The LORD is the defense of my life; Whom shall I dread?

Joh 8:12 Again therefore Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world; he who follows Me shall not walk in the darkness, but shall have the light of life."

Joh 1:4-9 In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. (5) And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it. (6) There came a man, sent from God, whose name was John. (7) He came for a witness, that he might bear witness of the light, that all might believe through him. (8) He was not the light, but *came* that he might bear witness of the light. (9) There was the true light which, coming into the world, enlightens every man.

Eph 6:12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual *forces* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*.

Col 1:13 For He delivered us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son,

*1Jn 1:6 If we say that we have fellowship with Him  
and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not  
practice the truth;*

1Jn 2:9 The one who says he is in the light and yet  
hates his brother is in the darkness until now. (10)  
The one who loves his brother abides in the light  
and there is no cause for stumbling in him. (11)  
But the one who hates his brother is in the  
darkness and walks in the darkness, and does not  
know where he is going because the darkness has  
blinded his eyes.

2Jn 1:9-11 Anyone who goes too far and does not abide in the teaching of Christ, does not have God; the one who abides in the teaching, he has both the Father and the Son. (10) If anyone comes to you and does not bring this teaching, do not receive him into *your* house, and do not give him a greeting; (11) for the one who gives him a greeting participates in his evil deeds.

*1Jn 1:7 but if we walk in the light as He Himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.*

Joh 8:12 Again therefore Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world; he who follows Me shall not walk in the darkness, but shall have the light of life."



We are only in the light if we walk  
with Him.

1Co 10:21 You cannot drink the cup  
of the Lord and the cup of demons;  
you cannot partake of the table of  
the Lord and the table of demons.

Zec 13:1 "In that day a fountain will be opened for the house of David and for the inhabitants of Jerusalem, for sin and for impurity.

Act 20:28 "Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.

Eph 1:7 In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace,

*1Jn 1:8 If we say that we have no sin, we are  
deceiving ourselves, and the truth is not in us.*

Rom 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of  
the glory of God,

Isa 53:6 All of us like sheep have gone astray,  
Each of us has turned to his own way; But the  
LORD has caused the iniquity of us all To fall  
on Him.

*1Jn 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.*

We confess to God; forgiveness is a prerogative of  
Deity

Mk 2:7,10 "Why does this man speak that way? He is blaspheming; who can forgive sins but God alone?" ... (10) "But in order that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins"--He \*said to the paralytic--

Jas 5:16 Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

We confess faults to each other Ja 5:16  
faults= failings Gr *parapatoma* not *harmatia* -- not sins - need help. Deity alone forgives sins.

*1Jn 1:10 If we say that we have not sinned,  
we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us.*

1Jn 2:4-5 The one who says, "I have come to  
know Him," and does not keep His  
commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not  
in him; (5) but whoever keeps His word, in  
him the love of God has truly been perfected.  
By this we know that we are in Him:
