

1Jn 2:1 *My little children, I am writing these things to you that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous;*

Heb 7:24-25 but He, on the other hand, because He abides forever, holds His priesthood permanently.
(25) Hence, also, He is able to save forever those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

1Ti 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator also between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,

1Jn 2:2 and He Himself is the propitiation for our sins; and not for ours only, but also for those of the whole world.

propitiation = atoning sacrifice (NIV)

Rom 5:11 And not only this, but we also exult in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation.

1Jn 2:3 And by this we know that we have come to know Him, if we keep His commandments.

Joh 14:15 "If you love Me, you will keep My commandments.

Joh 14:21 "He who has My commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves Me; and he who loves Me shall be loved by My Father, and I will love him, and will disclose Myself to him."

1Jn 2:4 The one who says, "I have come to know Him," and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him;

Tit 1:16 They profess to know God, but by their deeds they deny Him, being detestable and disobedient, and worthless for any good deed.

Joh 8:44 "You are of your father the devil, and you want to do the desires of your father. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him.

Whenever he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own nature; for he is a liar, and the father of lies.

1Jn 2:5 but whoever keeps His word, in him the love of God has truly been perfected. By this we know that we are in Him:

1Jn 5:13 These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, in order that you may know that you have eternal life.

Joh 3:36 "He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."

1Jn 2:6 the one who says he abides in Him ought himself to walk in the same manner as He walked.

Joh 8:12 Again therefore Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world; he who follows Me shall not walk in the darkness, but shall have the light of life."

1Co 11:1 Be imitators of me, just as I also am of Christ.

1Jn 2:7 Beloved, I am not writing a new commandment to you, but an old commandment which you have had from the beginning; the old commandment is the word which you have heard.

Joh 13:34-35 "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another. (35) "By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

Lev 19:18 ... but you shall love your neighbor as yourself; I am the LORD.

1Jn 2:8 On the other hand, I am writing a new commandment to you, which is true in Him and in you, because the darkness is passing away, and the true light is already shining.

Joh 8:12 Again therefore Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world; he who follows Me shall not walk in the darkness, but shall have the light of life."

2Pe 1:3 seeing that His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to life and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence.

1Jn 2:9 The one who says he is in the light and yet hates his brother is in the darkness until now.

2Pe 1:8-9 For if these qualities are yours and are increasing, they render you neither useless nor unfruitful in the true knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. (9) For he who lacks these qualities is blind or short-sighted, having forgotten his purification from his former sins.

1Jn 2:10 The one who loves his brother abides in the light and there is no cause for stumbling in him.

1Jn 3:18 Little children, let us not love with word or with tongue, but in deed and truth.

1Jn 2:11 But the one who hates his brother is in the darkness and walks in the darkness, and does not know where he is going because the darkness has blinded his eyes.

Does not contradict as Lk shows a priority

Luk 14:26 "If anyone comes to Me, and does not hate his own father and mother and wife and children and brothers and sisters, yes, and even his own life, he cannot be My disciple.

*1Jn 2:12 I am writing to you, little children,
because your sins are forgiven you for His name's

Gal 3:26-27 For you are all sons of God through
faith in Christ Jesus. (27) For all of you who were
baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with
Christ.

1Jn 2:13 I am writing to you, fathers, because you know Him who has been from the beginning. I am writing to you, young men, because you have overcome the evil one. I have written to you, children, because you know the Father.

Gal 3:26-27 For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. (27) For all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.

1Jn 2:14 I have written to you, fathers, because you know Him who has been from the beginning. I have written to you, young men, because you are strong, and the word of God abides in you, and you have overcome the evil one.

Heb 5:14 But solid food is for the mature, who because of practice have their senses trained to discern good and evil.

Eph 6:10 Finally, be strong in the Lord, and in the strength of His might.

1Jn 2:15 Do not love the world, nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

Mat 6:24 "No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will hold to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon.

1Jn 2:16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world.

Mt 4:1-11 lust of eye -kingdoms of world

lust of flesh - stone to bread

pride of life - pinnacle of temple -cast yourself

1Jn 2:17 And the world is passing away, and also its lusts; but the one who does the will of God abides forever.

Heb 10:36 For you have need of endurance, so that when you have done the will of God, you may receive what was promised. 39 But we are not of those who shrink back to destruction, but of those who have faith to the preserving of the soul.

Tit 1:2 in the hope of eternal life, which God, who cannot lie, promised long ages ago,

1Jn 2:18 Children, it is the last hour; and just as you heard that antichrist is coming, even now many antichrists have arisen; from this we know that it is the last hour.

2Th 2:3-4 Let no one in any way deceive you, for it will not come unless the apostasy comes first, and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of destruction, (4) who opposes and exalts himself above every so-called god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, displaying himself as being God.

1Jn 2:19 They went out from us, but they were not really of us; for if they had been of us, they would have remained with us; but they went out, in order that it might be shown that they all are not of us.

2Pe 2:20-21 For if after they have escaped the defilements of the world by the knowledge of the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, they are again entangled in them and are overcome, the last state has become worse for them than the first. (21) For it would be better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than having known it, to turn away from the holy commandment delivered to them.

*1Jn 2:20 But you have an anointing from the Holy One,
and you all know.*

2Ti 3:14-17 But as for you, continue in what you have
learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom

and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction,

1Jn 2:21 I have not written to you because you do not know the truth, but because you do know it, and because no lie is of the truth.

Joh 8:31-32 Jesus therefore was saying to those Jews who had believed Him, "If you abide in My word, then you are truly disciples of Mine; (32) and you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

Joh 17:17 "Sanctify them in the truth; Thy word is truth.

1Jn 2:22 Who is the liar but the one who denies that Jesus is the Christ? This is the antichrist, the one who denies the Father and the Son.

Joh 5:23 in order that all may honor the Son, even as they honor the Father. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent Him.

1Jn 2:23 Whoever denies the Son does not have the Father; the one who confesses the Son has the Father also.

Joh 1:18 No man has seen God at any time; the only begotten God, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has explained Him.

1Jn 2:24 As for you, let that abide in you which you heard from the beginning. If what you heard from the beginning abides in you, you also will abide in the Son and in the Father.

Heb 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today, yes and forever.

1Jn 2:25 And this is the promise which He Himself made to us: eternal life.

Tit 1:2 in the hope of eternal life, which God, who cannot lie, promised long ages ago,

1Jn 2:26 These things I have written to you concerning those who are trying to deceive you.

Gal 1:6 I am amazed that you are so quickly deserting Him who called you by the grace of Christ, for a different gospel;

1Ti 4:1-3 But the Spirit explicitly says that in later times some will fall away from the faith, paying attention to deceitful spirits and doctrines of demons, (2) by means of the hypocrisy of liars seared in their own conscience as with a branding iron, (3) men who forbid marriage and advocate abstaining from foods, which God has created to be gratefully shared in by those who believe and know the truth.

1Jn 2:27 And as for you, the anointing which you received from Him abides in you, and you have no need for anyone to teach you; but as His anointing teaches you about all things, and is true and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you abide in Him.

Joh 12:48 "He who rejects Me, and does not receive My sayings, has one who judges him; the word I spoke is what will judge him at the last day.

1Jn 2:28 And now, little children, abide in Him, so that when He appears, we may have confidence and not shrink away from Him in shame at His coming.

Col 2:6 As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him,

1Jn 2:29 If you know that He is righteous, you know that everyone also who practices righteousness is born of Him.

Joh 3:3-5 Jesus answered and said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God." (4) Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? He cannot enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born, can he?" (5) Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.
