

1Jn 3:1 *See how great a love the Father has bestowed upon us, that we should be called children of God; and such we are. For this reason the world does not know us, because it did not know Him.*

Rom 8:14 For all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.

2Co 6:18 "And I will be a father to you, And you shall be sons and daughters to Me," Says the Lord Almighty.

Joh 15:17-19 "This I command you, that you love one another. (18) "If the world hates you, you know that it has hated Me before *it hated* you. (19) "If you were of the world, the world would love its own; but because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you.

1Jn 3:2 Beloved, now we are children of God, and it has not appeared as yet what we shall be. We know that, when He appears, we shall be like Him, because we shall see Him just as He is.

1Co 15:34-35 Become sober-minded as you ought, and stop sinning; for some have no knowledge of God. I speak *this* to your shame. (35) But someone will say, "How are the dead raised? And with what kind of body do they come?"

1Jn 3:3 And everyone who has this hope fixed on Him purifies himself, just as He is pure.

1Jn 1:7-9 but if we walk in the light as He Himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin. (8) If we say that we have no sin, we are deceiving ourselves, and the truth is not in us. (9) If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

1Jn 3:4 Everyone who practices sin also practices lawlessness; and sin is lawlessness.

Rom 4:15 for the Law brings about wrath, but where there is no law, neither is there violation.

1Jn 3:5 And you know that He appeared in order to take away sins; and in Him there is no sin.

Mat 1:21 "And she will bear a Son; and you shall call His name Jesus, for it is He who will save His people from their sins."

1Pe 2:21-22 For you have been called for this purpose, since Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example for you to follow in His steps, (22) WHO COMMITTED NO SIN, NOR WAS ANY DECEIT FOUND IN HIS MOUTH;

1Jn 3:6 No one who abides in Him sins; no one who sins has seen Him or knows Him.

“who sins” sinneth (KJV) Singular Present active indicative (usually continued action)

Joh 15:4 "Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, so neither *can* you, unless you abide in Me.
... 10 "If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love; just as I have kept My Father's commandments, and abide in His love.

1Jn 3:7 Little children, let no one deceive you; the one who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He is righteous; 8 the one who practices sin is of the devil; for the devil has sinned from the beginning. The Son of God appeared for this purpose, that He might destroy the works of the devil.

practices (doeth - KJV)

Heb 2:14 Since then the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of the same, that through death He might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil

*1Jn 3:9 No one who is born of God practices sin,
because His seed abides in him; and he cannot sin,
because he is born of God.*

NAS – Bad translation - “cannot commit sin” KJV,
NASV -- Pres Act Infin-- “and he cannot go on
sinning” as in NIV “cannot keep sinning” ESV

Rom 6:1-2 What shall we say then? Are we to
continue in sin that grace may abound? (2) By no
means! How can we who died to sin still live in it?

1Jn 3:10 By this the children of God and the children of the devil are obvious: anyone who does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor the one who does not love his brother.

Eph 5:1-2 Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children. (2) And walk in love, as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.

Joh 8:44 You are of your father the devil, and your will is to do your father's desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks out of his own character, for he is a liar and the father of lies.

1Jn 3:11 For this is the message which you have heard from the beginning, that we should love one another;

Joh 13:35 By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

1Jn 3:12 not as Cain, who was of the evil one, and slew his brother. And for what reason did he slay him? Because his deeds were evil, and his brother's were righteous.

Gen 4:5-7 but for Cain and his offering he had no regard. So Cain was very angry, and his face fell. (6) The LORD said to Cain, "Why are you angry, and why has your face fallen? (7) If you do well, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well, sin is crouching at the door. Its desire is for you, but you must rule over it."

1Jn 3:13 Do not marvel, brethren, if the world hates you.

Joh 15:17-19 These things I command you, so that you will love one another. (18) "If the world hates you, know that it has hated me before it hated you. (19) If you were of the world, the world would love you as its own; but because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you.

2Ti 3:12 Indeed, all who desire to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted,

1Jn 3:14 We know that we have passed out of death into life, because we love the brethren. He who does not love abides in death.

1Jn 5:12 Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life.

Joh 3:18 Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.

1Jn 3:15 Everyone who hates his brother is a murderer; and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him. 16 We know love by this, that He laid down His life for us; and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.

Rom 5:8 but God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Php 2:5-8 Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, (6) who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, (7) but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, *and* being made in the likeness of men. (8) And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

1Jn 3:17 But whoever has the world's goods, and beholds his brother in need and closes his heart against him, how does the love of God abide in him?

Jas 1:27 This is pure and undefiled religion in the sight of *our* God and Father, to visit orphans and widows in their distress, *and* to keep oneself unstained by the world.

Gal 6:10 So then, while we have opportunity, let us do good to all men, and especially to those who are of the household of the faith.

1Jn 3:18 Little children, let us not love with word or with tongue, but in deed and truth.

1Pe 1:22 Since you have in obedience to the truth purified your souls for a sincere love of the brethren, fervently love one another from the heart,

Jas 2:20 But are you willing to recognize, you foolish fellow, that faith without works is useless?

*1Jn 3:19 We shall know by this that we are of the truth,
and shall assure our heart before Him, 20 in whatever
our heart condemns us; for God is greater than our
heart, and knows all things.*

Jas 1:23-25 For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks at his natural face in a mirror; (24) for *once* he has looked at himself and gone away, he has immediately forgotten what kind of person he was. (25) But one who looks intently at the perfect law, the *law* of liberty, and abides by it, not having become a forgetful hearer but an effectual doer, this man shall be blessed in what he does.

1Jn 3:21 Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence before God; 22 and whatever we ask we receive from Him, because we keep His commandments and do the things that are pleasing in His sight.

Jas 4:2-3 You lust and do not have; so you commit murder. And you are envious and cannot obtain; so you fight and quarrel. You do not have because you do not ask. (3) You ask and do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, so that you may spend *it* on your pleasures.

1Jn 3:23 And this is His commandment, that we believe in the name of His Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, just as He commanded us.

Joh 20:30-31 Many other signs therefore Jesus also performed in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; (31) but these have been written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing you may have life in His name.

1Jn 3:24 And the one who keeps His commandments abides in Him, and He in him. And we know by this that He abides in us, by the Spirit whom He has given us.

Eph 1:13 In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation--having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise,
