1Jn 5:1 Whoever believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God; and whoever loves the Father loves the child born of Him.

It must be an obedient belief.

Joh 12:42-43 Nevertheless many even of the rulers believed in Him, but because of the Pharisees they were not confessing Him, lest they should be put out of the synagogue; (43) for they loved the approval of men rather than the approval of God. Jas 2:19 You believe that God is one. You do well; the demons also believe, and shudder.

Joh 3:36 "He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who <u>does not obey</u> the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him." (note KJV does not do a good job on this verse – "believeth not" ASV, NAS, ESV follow above) 1Jn 5:2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and observe His commandments.

Joh 13:34-35 "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another. (35) "By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

1Jn 3:18 Little children, let us not love with word or with tongue, but in deed and truth.

1Jn 5:3 For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments; and His commandments are not burdensome.

Jas 2:15-17 If a brother or sister is without clothing and in need of daily food, (16) and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, be warmed and be filled," and yet you do not give them what is necessary for *their* body, what use is that? (17) Even so faith, if it has no works, is dead, *being* by itself. 1Jn 5:4 For whatever is born of God overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has overcome the world--our faith.

Joh 3:3-5 Jesus answered and said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God." (4) Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? He cannot enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born, can he?" (5) Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

Jas 2:18 But someone may *well* say, "You have faith, and I have works; show me your faith without the works, and I will show you my faith by my works."

## 1Jn 5:5 And who is the one who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

Rev 17:14 "These will wage war against the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, because He is Lord of lords and King of kings, and those who are with Him *are the* called and chosen and faithful." 1Jn 5:6 This is the one who came by water and blood, Jesus Christ; not with the water only, but with the water and with the blood.

Luk 3:21-22 Now it came about when all the people were baptized, that Jesus also was baptized, and while He was praying, heaven was opened, (22) and the Holy Spirit descended upon Him in bodily form like a dove, and a voice came out of heaven, "Thou art My beloved Son, in Thee I am well-pleased."

Joh 19:34 but one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately there came out blood and water. 1Jn 5:7 And it is the Spirit who bears witness, because the Spirit is the truth.

Joh 14:26 "But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you.

Disputed part contained in no Greek manuscript before Codex 61 translation from Latin to Greek dated at1500 caused Erasmus to insert this in his text later revised to the KJV. 1Jn 5:8 For there are three that bear witness, the Spirit and the water and the blood; and the three are in agreement.

His baptism, His crucifixion, the Holy Spirit

1Jn 5:9 If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater; for the witness of God is this, that He has borne witness concerning His Son.

Luk 3:21-22 Now it came about when all the people were baptized, that Jesus also was baptized, and while He was praying, heaven was opened, (22) and the Holy Spirit descended upon Him in bodily form like a dove, and a voice came out of heaven, "Thou art My beloved Son, in Thee I am well-pleased."

## At His transfiguration

Mat 17:5 While he was still speaking, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them; and behold, a voice out of the cloud, saying, "This is My beloved Son, with whom I am well-pleased; listen to Him!"

1Jn 5:10 The one who believes in the Son of God has the witness in himself; the one who does not believe God has made Him a liar, because he has not believed in the witness that God has borne concerning His Son.

Act 2:38 And Peter said to them, "Repent, and let each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. 1Jn 5:11 And the witness is this, that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son.

Joh 10:28 and I give eternal life to them, and they shall never perish; and no one shall snatch them out of My hand. 1Jn 5:12 He who has the Son has the life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have the life.

Heb 7:25 Hence, also, He is able to save forever those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them. 1Jn 5:13 These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, in order that you may know that you have eternal life.

Joh 20:30-31 Many other signs therefore Jesus also performed in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; (31) but these have been written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing you may have life in His name. 1Jn 5:14 And this is the confidence which we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.

Jas 4:3 You ask and do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, so that you may spend *it* on your pleasures.

1Jn 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 1Jn 5:15 And if we know that He hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests which we have asked from Him.

2Co 12:8-9 Concerning this I entreated the Lord three times that it might depart from me. (9) And He has said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for power is perfected in weakness." Most gladly, therefore, I will rather boast about my weaknesses, that the power of Christ may dwell in me. 1Jn 5:16 If anyone sees his brother committing a sin not leading to death, he shall ask and God will for him give life to those who commit sin not leading to death. There is a sin leading to death; I do not say that he should make request for this.

Mat 12:31-32 "Therefore I say to you, any sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven men, but blasphemy against the Spirit shall not be forgiven. (32) "And whoever shall speak a word against the Son of Man, it shall be forgiven him; but whoever shall speak against the Holy Spirit, it shall not be forgiven him, either in this age, or in the *age* to come. This is the sin of which Jesus speaks

Mat 12:24 But when the Pharisees heard it, they said, "This man casts out demons only by Beelzebul the ruler of the demons."

Jesus prayed for a sin for which the doers had not repented.

Luk 23:34 But Jesus was saying, "Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing." And they cast lots, dividing up His garments among themselves. 1Jn 5:17 All unrighteousness is sin, and there is a sin not leading to death.

Isa 59:1-2 Behold, the LORD's hand is not so short That it cannot save; Neither is His ear so dull That it cannot hear. (2) But your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God, And your sins have hidden *His* face from you, so that He does not hear.

1Jn 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 1Jn 5:18 We know that no one who is born of God sins; but He who was born of God keeps him and the evil one does not touch him.

Can't continue to practice sin as in 3:4

1Co 10:13 No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, that you may be able to endure it. 1Jn 5:19 We know that we are of God, and the whole world lies in the power of the evil one.

Col 1:13 For He delivered us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son,

1Jn 5:20 And we know that the Son of God has come, and has given us understanding, in order that we might know Him who is true, and we are in Him who is true, in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God and eternal life.

Isa 9:6-7 For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. (7) There will be no end to the increase of *His* government or of peace, On the throne of David and over his kingdom, To establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness From then on and forevermore. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will accomplish this.

Rom 6:4-5 Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death, in order that as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life. (5) For if we have become united with *Him* in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall be also *in the likeness* of His resurrection,

Act 17:24-25 "The God who made the world and all things in it, since He is Lord of heaven and earth, does not dwell in temples made with hands; (25) neither is He served by human hands, as though He needed anything, since He Himself gives to all life and breath and all things;

## 1Jn 5:21 Little children, guard yourselves from idols.

Rom 1:23-25 and exchanged the glory of the incorruptible God for an image in the form of corruptible man and of birds and four-footed animals and crawling creatures. (24) Therefore God gave them over in the lusts of their hearts to impurity, that their bodies might be dishonored among them. (25) For they exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen.
