

(3) Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the words of the prophecy, and heed the things which are written in it; for the time is near.

Revelation by Jesus' angel, i.e. a messenger v. 2 angel of churches Rev 2:1,8,12,18; 3:1, 7,14

C.I. Scofield popularized dispensational premillennialism through the Scofield Reference Bible, first released in 1909. Moved from Lutheran to Presbyterian to **Congregationalism to Southern** Presbyterian



7 church ages with Jesus returning to set up an earthly kingdom reigning in Jerusalem. Required Prophetic postponement to His bond-servant John, (2) who testified to the word of God and to the testimony of Jesus Christ, even to all that he saw.

Joh 20:30 Therefore many other signs Jesus also performed in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; (31) but these have been written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing you may have life in His name. (3) Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the words of the prophecy, and heed the things which are written in it; for the time is near.

Joh 13:17 "If you know these things, you are blessed if you do them.

Rev 1:4-5 John to the seven churches that are in Asia: Grace to you and peace, from Him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven Spirits who are before His throne, (5) and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth.

From the God head: God, the eternal Father, the Holy Spirit (7 is used for completeness), From Jesus Christ, now in His eternal kingdom. John also addresses Jesus once again – Rev 1.5...To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood (6) and made us a kingdom, priests to his God and Father, to him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

Not kings (KJV)

Mar 9:1 And Jesus was saying to them, "Truly I say to you, there are some of those who are standing here who will not taste death until they see the kingdom of God after it has come with power." Col 1:12-13 giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in Light. (13) For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son,

and the last, the beginning and the end."


Rev 1:9 I, John, your brother and fellow partaker in the tribulation and kingdom and perseverance which are in Jesus, was on the island called Patmos because of the word of God and the testimony of Jesus.

Dan 2:44 "In the days of those kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which will never be destroyed,

Act 14:22 ... "Through many tribulations we must enter the kingdom of God."

Col 1:13 For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the <u>kingdom of His</u> <u>beloved Son</u>,

Patmos according to tradition - Irenaeus. Eusebius, Jerome; John was exiled here-- in the 14th year of the reign of Domitian and returned to Ephesus under Nerva (96 AD). (ISBE);

*Rev 1:10 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and I heard behind me a loud voice like the sound of a trumpet,* 

"in the spirit" -- a vision on Lord's day (that belonging to Gr kuriakee heemera only here and of supper in 1Co 11:20 Therefore when you meet together, it is not to eat the Lord's Supper, -- not day of judgment II Pet 3:10 heermera kurion (Robertson) 2Pe 3:10 But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, in which the heavens will pass away with a roar and the elements will be destroyed with intense heat,

Rev 1:11 saying, "Write in a book what you see, and send it to the seven churches: to Ephesus and to Smyrna and to Pergamum and to Thyatira and to Sardis and to Philadelphia and to Laodicea."

Representing all the churches of all times 7 =complete

Rev 1:12 Then I turned to see the voice that was speaking with me. And having turned I saw seven golden lampstands;

*Rev 1:20 "As for the mystery* of the seven stars which you saw in My right hand, and the seven golden lampstands: the seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands are the seven churches.



Rev 1:13 and in the middle of the lampstands I saw one like a son of man, clothed in a robe reaching to the feet, and girded across His chest with a golden sash.

Joh 1:14 And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

Rev 14:14 Then I looked, and behold, a white cloud, and sitting on the cloud was one like a son of man, having a golden crown on His head and a sharp sickle in His hand.

Dan 7:13-14 "I kept looking in the night visions, And behold, with the clouds of heaven One like a Son of Man was coming, And He came up to the Ancient of Days And was presented before Him. (14) "And to Him was given dominion, Glory and a kingdom, That all the peoples, nations and men of every language Might serve Him. *Rev 1:14-16 His head and His hair were white like* white wool, like snow; and His eyes were like a flame of fire. (15) His feet were like burnished bronze, when it has been made to glow in a furnace, and His voice was like the sound of many waters. (16) In His right hand He held seven stars, and out of His mouth came a sharp two-edged sword; and His face was like the sun shining in its strength.

Not the man John knew on earth but a magnificent image of beauty, power and majesty.

The interpretation of the vision thus far. Notice the emphasis on perfect number -7
