

*2Co 6:1 And working together with
Him, we also urge you not to receive
the grace of God in vain--*

2Ti 2:2 And the things which you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses, these entrust to faithful men, who will be able to teach others also.

Gal 5:4 You have been severed
from Christ, you who are seeking
to be justified by law; you have
fallen from grace.

2Pe 3:16 as also in all his letters,
speaking in them of these things,
in which are some things hard to
understand, which the untaught
and unstable distort, as they do
also the rest of the Scriptures, to
their own destruction.

*2Co 6:2 for He says, "AT THE
ACCEPTABLE TIME I LISTENED TO
YOU, AND ON THE DAY OF SALVATION
I HELPED YOU"; behold, now is "THE
ACCEPTABLE TIME," behold, now is
"THE DAY OF SALVATION"--*

1Jn 1:7 but if we walk in the light
as He Himself is in the light, we
have fellowship with one another,
and the blood of Jesus His Son
cleanses us from all sin.

Heb 12:1 Therefore, since we have
so great a cloud of witnesses
surrounding us, let us also lay aside
every encumbrance, and the sin
which so easily entangles us, and
let us run with endurance the race
that is set before us,

*2Co 6:3 giving no cause for offense in
anything, in order that the ministry
be not discredited,*

2Co 8:21 for we have regard for
what is honorable, not only in the
sight of the Lord, but also in the
sight of men.

*2Co 6:4 but in everything
commending ourselves as servants of
God, in much endurance, in
afflictions, in hardships, in distresses,*

2Ti 4:5 But you, be sober in all things, endure hardship, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.

2Co 11:28 Apart from such external things, there is the daily pressure upon me of concern for all the churches.

*2Co 6:5 in beatings, in
imprisonments, in tumults, in labors,
in sleeplessness, in hunger,*

2Co 11:24-25 Five times I received
from the Jews thirty-nine lashes.
(25) Three times I was beaten with
rods, once I was stoned, three
times I was shipwrecked, a night
and a day I have spent in the deep.

*2Co 6:6 in purity, in knowledge, in
patience, in kindness, in the Holy
Spirit, in genuine love,*

Rom 12:9-10 Let love be without
hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil; cling
to what is good. (10) Be devoted
to one another in brotherly love;
give preference to one another in
honor;

Php 4:8 Finally, brethren,
whatever is true, whatever is
honorable, whatever is right,
whatever is pure, whatever is
lovely, whatever is of good repute,
if there is any excellence and if
anything worthy of praise, let your
mind dwell on these things.

*2Co 6:7 in the word of truth, in the
power of God; by the weapons of
righteousness for the right hand and
the left,*

1Co 2:4 And my message and my
preaching were not in persuasive
words of wisdom, but in
demonstration of the Spirit and of
power,

Rom 1:16 For I am not ashamed of
the gospel, for it is the power of
God for salvation to everyone who
believes, to the Jew first and also
to the Greek.

*2Co 6:8 by glory and dishonor, by evil
report and good report; regarded as
deceivers and yet true;*

2Co 10:10 For they say, "His letters are weighty and strong, but his personal presence is unimpressive, and his speech contemptible."

*2Co 6:10 as sorrowful yet always
rejoicing, as poor yet making many
rich, as having nothing yet possessing
all things.*

1Pe 4:12-13 Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal among you, which comes upon you for your testing, as though some strange thing were happening to you; (13) but to the degree that you share the sufferings of Christ, keep on rejoicing; so that also at the revelation of His glory, you may rejoice with exultation.

2Co 6:14 Do not be bound together with unbelievers; for what partnership have righteousness and lawlessness, or what fellowship has light with darkness?

Forbids religious sharing

Eph 5:7 Therefore do not be partakers with them; not spouses or it would be a direct contradiction of his statements

Ezr 10:2 And Shecaniah the son of Jehiel, one of the sons of Elam, answered and said to Ezra, "We have been unfaithful to our God, and have married foreign women from the peoples of the land; yet now there is hope for Israel in spite of this.

1Co 7:12-13 But to the rest I say, not the Lord, that if any brother has a wife who is an unbeliever, and she consents to live with him, let him not send her away. (13) And a woman who has an unbelieving husband, and he consents to live with her, let her not send her husband away.

1Co 5:9-10 I wrote you in my letter
not to associate with immoral
people; (10) I did not at all mean
with the immoral people of this
world, or with the covetous and
swindlers, or with idolaters; for
then you would have to go out of
the world.

Tit 2:11-12 For the grace of God
has appeared, bringing salvation to
all men, (12) instructing us to
deny ungodliness and worldly
desires and to live sensibly,
righteously and godly in the
present age,

*2Co 6:15 Or what harmony has
Christ with Belial, or what has a
believer in common with an
unbeliever?*

Belial (means worthlessness and refers to Satan). Thus, we cannot continue to worship idols after we have chosen the way of grace.

2Co 6:16 Or what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; just as God said, "I WILL DWELL IN THEM AND WALK AMONG THEM; AND I WILL BE THEIR GOD, AND THEY SHALL BE MY PEOPLE.

Eph 2:20-22 having been built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the corner stone, (21) in whom the whole building, being fitted together is growing into a holy temple in the Lord; (22) in whom you also are being built together into a dwelling of God in the Spirit.

Paul did things that we know are
harmful to the body.

2Co 11:27 I have been in labor and
hardship, through many sleepless
nights, in hunger and thirst, often
without food, in cold and
exposure.

Paul even allowed himself to be beaten.

Act 16:22, 38 And the crowd rose up together against them, and the chief magistrates tore their robes off them, and proceeded to order them to be beaten with rods ... (38) And the policemen reported these words to the chief magistrates. And they were afraid when they heard that they were Romans,

*2Co 6:17 "Therefore, COME OUT
FROM THEIR MIDST AND BE
SEPARATE," says the Lord. "AND DO
NOT TOUCH WHAT IS UNCLEAN; And
I will welcome you.*

Food (including meat, grease, salt,
etc.) is not the problem, sin is!

1Ti 4:4, 8 For everything created by God is good, and nothing is to be rejected, if it is received with gratitude ... (8) for bodily discipline is only of little profit, but godliness is profitable for all things, since it holds promise for the present life and also for the life to come.

Rom 6:1-2 What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin that grace might increase? (2)
May it never be! How shall we who died to sin still live in it?

*2Co 6:18 "And I will be a father to
you, And you shall be sons and
daughters to Me," Says the Lord
Almighty.*

Rom 8:14 For all who are being led
by the Spirit of God, these are sons
of God.

Gal 3:26 For you are all sons of God
through faith in Christ Jesus.

4:5-7 in order that He might redeem those
who were under the Law, that we might
receive the adoption as sons. (6) And
because you are sons, God has sent forth
the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying,
"Abba! Father!" (7) Therefore you are no
longer a slave, but a son; and if a son, then
an heir through God.
