One answer is certain and that is we must not be guided by hate but by what God would have us do. The Old Testament is clear about what the children of Israel were to do with immigrants

Exo 34:12 "Watch yourself that you make no covenant with the inhabitants of the land into which you are going, lest it become a snare in your midst.

Act 10:28 And he said to them, "You yourselves know how unlawful it is for a man who is a Jew to associate with a foreigner or to visit him; and yet God has shown me that I should not call any man unholy or unclean.

Ezr 10:2 And Shecaniah the son of Jehiel, one of the sons of Elam, answered and said to Ezra, "We have been unfaithful to our God, and have married foreign women from the peoples of the land; yet now there is hope for Israel in spite of this.

A foreigner had to become a Jew in order to stay with them Ex 12:43-48

How can we protect people who continue to hold to their “ideologies of hatred” from themselves and their fellow believers?

The problem they face is the evil rooted in Islam – through the Quran and the Imams.

Pro 6:27 Can a man take fire in his bosom, And his clothes not be burned?

Islam IS the problem. It is the violent teaching of the Quran that drives Muslims to terrorism. The more a Muslim tries to follow the Quran, the more likely it is that he will become violent. That is why terrorist training camps teach the Quran.

From the Quran [9.29] Fight those who do not believe in Allah, nor in the latter day, nor do they prohibit what Allah and His Apostle have prohibited, nor follow the religion of truth, out of those who have been given the Book, until they pay the tax in acknowledgment of superiority and they are in a state of subjection.

[2.191] And kill them wherever you find them, and drive them out from whence they drove you out, and persecution is severer than slaughter.

A Muslim cannot be both a “good” Muslim and a “good” American.

(9.23) O ye who believe! Choose not your fathers nor your brethren for friends if they take pleasure in disbelief rather than faith. Whoso of you taketh them for friends, such are wrong-doers.

The religious war is bigger than we know or understand. We are affected by it but our children will bear the burden of our decisions about it.

President Obama stated (6/4/09), “America and Islam are not exclusive. Instead, they overlap, and share common principles - principles of justice and progress; tolerance and the dignity of all human beings.”

This is simply not true!

Islamic justice does not extend to non-Muslims. Quran 48:29, says ‘Muhammad is the messenger of Allah; and those who are with him are **harsh** against Unbelievers, (but) compassionate amongst each other.’

The President is not alone in this misunderstanding. He doesn't know the Bible or the Quran, but neither do many leaders of the denominations.

“Over 300 prominent Christian leaders signed a letter issued by the Yale Center for Faith and Culture claiming that world peace is dependent on Muslims and Christians recognizing 'Allah' and 'Yahweh' as the same God. This letter, titled 'Loving God and Neighbor Together,' was written in response to a signed document by 138 Muslim leaders titled 'A Common Word Between Us and You.' Brian McLaren (Time Magazine's "Top 25 Evangelicals), Rick Warren (author of a "Purpose Driven Life"), Robert Schuller (of Crystal Cathedral fame) and Bill Hybels (of Willow Creek church) were just several of the signatories to this outright betrayal of Christ!" (6/24/11)

A Christian in the military writes, “Here is an unbiased truthful view to the Syrian refugee situation. In 2006, my unit voluntarily ran a children’s burn clinic outside of the FOB. It was a constant target for attacks. You would think that people wouldn't shoot mortars or rockets at their own children, but you would be wrong.”

“We saw hundreds of children, from infants to 18 year olds. The overwhelming majority of the kids we saw (90% or better) were clear cases of abuse. These parents were literally dunking their kids in boiling water, or throwing hot chai at their kids faces... Yes, we're talking about babies, toddlers, kids not even old enough to understand why their parents would do these things to them. HUNDREDS of kids...”

We saw quite a few of these kids that were [...] abused, both girls and boys. Their parents acted if nothing was wrong with this, even when confronted by our doctors. This is the mentality of their society, not the viewpoint of a few individuals... these beliefs have been accepted to the vast majority of these people. Many were educated, well dressed, well spoken men, but yet, they still [abused] their own children, ...

These guys also kept a "chai boy" A boy, about 11 years old, who was there to serve these guys [...]. We heard him being [abused] many times, but there was nothing we could do about it. We asked the police, the Afghan Army, and we were told the same thing every time.... it's their culture, and accepted as the norm....

You might ask if these immigrants could not be converted to Christianity.

Qur'an (4:89) - "... therefore take not to yourselves friends of them, until they emigrate in the way of God; then, if they turn their backs, take them, and slay them wherever you find them; take not to yourselves any one of them as friend or helper."

They are to be killed by Muslims wherever they go.

Geographically – no ... Because his allegiance is to Mecca, to which he turns in prayer five times a day (18.26).

Socially – no ... Because his
allegiance to Islam forbids him to
make friends with Christians or Jews
(9.23).

Morally- no ... Because Mohammed was a pedophile, marrying A'isha when she was 6 and consummating the marriage when she was 9, Hadith - Muslim 8:3309 Bukhari 58:234 and his followers are to follow his example (33.021).

Domestically – no ... Because he is instructed to marry four women and beat his wife when she disobeys him.(4.3, 34)

(4.34) : “Men have authority over women because God has made the one superior to the other, and because they spend their wealth to maintain them. Good women are obedient. As for those from whom you fear disobedience, admonish them and send them to beds apart and beat them. Then if they obey you, take no further action against them. God is high, supreme.”

Intellectually – no ... By following the Quran, a Muslim does not seek knowledge outside the Quran (5.101-102).

There is no indication of any science due to Muslims during the middle ages that did not come from conquered peoples.

Philosophically – no ... Because Islam, Muhammad, and the Quran do not allow freedom of religion and expression. Democracy and Islam cannot co-exist. Every Muslim government is either dictatorial or autocratic. (45.21, 59; 9.3)

Spiritually – no ... Because when we declare “one nation under God,” the Muslim cannot be a part unless the nation is under Islam and Allah, (5.49; 18.26) or he seeks to deceive the unbelievers so Islam can subvert the nation

Islam teaches that God has no Son. “And they say, 'The All-merciful has taken unto Himself a son. You have indeed advanced something hideous! The heavens are wellnigh rent of it and the earth split asunder, and the mountains wellnigh fall down crashing for that they have attributed to the All-merciful a son; and it behooves not the All-merciful to take a son. ... (19:88-93)

2Jn 1:9-11 Everyone who goes on ahead and does not abide in the teaching of Christ, does not have God. Whoever abides in the teaching has both the Father and the Son. (10) If anyone comes to you and does not bring this teaching, do not receive him into your house or give him any greeting, (11) for whoever greets him takes part in his wicked works.

Most startling to me was the comment, “Look at the rape statistics in Denmark, Sweden, Belgium.

Facts don't lie... 97% of rapes committed in Sweden were committed by Muslim immigrants ...”

“A 1996 Swedish National Council for Crime Prevention report bears this out. It noted that Muslim immigrants from North Africa were 23 times more likely to commit rape than Swedish men.”

Eph 5:5 For this you know with certainty, that no immoral or impure person or covetous man, who is an idolater, has an inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God. ... (7) Therefore do not be partakers with them; (8) for you were formerly darkness, but now you are light in the Lord; walk as children of light ... (11) And do not participate in the unfruitful deeds of darkness, but instead even expose them;

“Don't forget what they did to the Egyptian Coptic Christians [*21 beheaded 2/15/15*], or the Jordanian pilot [*burned alive 2/3/15*]... Don't forget about what they do to rape victims! They stone these women to death for being raped! [*10/28/14, Bequba*] They behead their own people. Do you think they will show mercy to you?”

Many attribute these things to “radical Islam”, but these Muslims are only doing what the Quran tells them to do.

What shall we as Christians do?

Mat 28:19-20 "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, (20) teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

As Jesus sent out the 12 to preach to the Jews, He didn't tell them go where men would not listen to them.

Mat 10:14 "And whoever does not receive you, nor heed your words, as you go out of that house or that city, shake off the dust of your feet. 15 "Truly I say to you, it will be more tolerable for the land of Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of judgment, than for that city.

There is a vast difference between Islam
and Christianity.

In fact, Islam and Christianity have so little
in common it is hard to believe that a
knowledgeable person would think that any
nation on earth controlled by Islam could
ever be at peace with a nation that wasn't
of the same sect of Islam – the Quran will
not allow it.

(3) This is good, and it is pleasing in the sight of God our Savior, (4) who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

We live in a country where we can choose our leaders. We need to choose them wisely.

When you think of the evil represented by Islam, think carefully of the goodness of the God of the Bible who calls us through His word to accept the gift of His son.

Rom 11:26 ... "The Deliverer will come from Zion, he will banish ungodliness from Jacob"; (27) "and this will be my covenant with them when I take away their sins." ... 29 For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.
