Learning about evolution when I go away to college.

What do students study where they learn about evolution.

Biology, geology, anthropology Where are these courses required?

Biology is required for agriculture, nursing, hygiene, environmental studies, medicine, ophthalmology, veterinary medicine, and wildlife studies.

However, a life science course is required by most universities for general background.

In such courses, a major topic is evolution (out of 4 major topics studied).

In my view, there is no reason for this to be included other than atheistic religious conviction on how life began as evolution plays no part in thinking or planning for any industrial or scientific technology career.

Again, evolution plays no part in the practice of agriculture, nursing, hygiene, environmental studies, medicine, ophthalmology, veterinary medicine, and wildlife studies.

It is purely a subjective, wholly nonmathematical view of the origin of life.

"We are currently seeing species go extinct. Between 1.4 and 1.8 million species have already been scientifically identified If the low estimate of the number of species out there is true - i.e. that there are around 2 million different species on our planet** - then that means between 200 and 2,000 extinctions occur every year.

- that there are 100 million different species coexisting with us on our planet - then between 10,000 and 100,000 species are becoming extinct each year." as the Cretaceous—Tertiary (K–T) extinction, was a mass extinction of some three-quarters of the plant and animal species on Earth—including all non-avian dinosaurs—that occurred over a geologically short period of time approximately 66 million years ago -Wikipedia

Species on earth? About 8.7 million (give or take 1.3 million) is the new, estimated total number of species on Earth -- the most precise calculation ever offered -- with 6.5 million species on land and 2.2 million in oceans. Aug 24, 2011

If we take the 66 million years ago extinction of 75% and the 8.7 million species now, we calculate 6.5 million new species must have "evolved" in the last 66 million years. That's 10 new species every year but we're losing species at the rate of 2000 per year. Panda.org

Ahmed Djoghlaf, head of the U.N. Convention on Biological Diversity says we're losing 55,000 species per year (May 2007)

Bill Nye, the "Science guy" says there are 30 million species on earth.

There's a lot of wild guesses out there. No one really knows how many species there are or how many disappear each hour.

Nye is at one end – 30 million species

If 75% were wiped out 66 million years ago— that's

22.5 million species.

But Djoghlaf says we're losing 55,000 per year and we're only gaining an average of 3 per year to replace the 22.5 in the 66 million – where did all the species come from?

Do you get the idea that the biologists can't count? At a loss of 55,000 species a year, it would only take 545 years for us to run completely out of species! Has this been going on ever since Europeans came to the US?

Why do biologists believe so much in Darwinian evolution?

Because the only other answer is God!
