*Rev 22:1-2 Then the angel showed me the river of the water of life, as clear as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb (2) down the middle of the great street of the city. On each side of the river stood the tree of life, bearing twelve crops of fruit, yielding its fruit every month. And the leaves of the tree are for the healing of the nations.*

Gal 3:13 Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written:  
"Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree."

*Rev 22:3 No longer will there be any curse.  
The throne of God and of the Lamb will be in  
the city, and his servants will serve him.*

1 Cor 16:22 If anyone does not love the Lord,  
let him be accursed. Maranatha.

*Rev 22:3 No longer will there be anything accursed, but the throne of God and of the Lamb will be in it, and his servants will worship him.*

We are his bond-servants

Rev 1:1 The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Him to show to His bond-servants , the things which must shortly take place; and He sent and communicated it by His angel to His bond-servant John,

He is on the throne and we share in throne

Acts 2:30 "And so, because he was a prophet, and knew that God had sworn to him with an oath to seat one of his descendants upon his throne, 31 he looked ahead and spoke of the resurrection of the Christ,

Rev 3:21 'He who overcomes, I will grant to him to sit down with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.

*Rev 22:4 They will see his face, and his name  
will be on their foreheads.*

2 Cor 4:6 For God, who said, "Light shall  
shine out of darkness," is the One who has  
shone in our hearts to give the light of the  
knowledge of the glory of God in the face of  
Christ.

*Rev 22:5-6 And night will be no more. They will need no light of lamp or sun, for the Lord God will be their light, and they will reign forever and ever. (6) And he said to me, “These words are trustworthy and true. And the Lord, the God of the spirits of the prophets, has sent his angel to show his servants what must soon take place.”*

a reign of unlimited duration (future active tense)

in God’s time not ours -- things take place shortly  
-- all of the events in these pages take place over  
and over again in the gospel age.

2Pe 3:8 But do not overlook this one fact, beloved,  
that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years,  
and a thousand years as one day.

*Rev 22:7 “And behold, I am coming soon. Blessed  
is the one who keeps the words of the prophecy of  
this book.”*

*Rev 22:8 I, John, am the one who heard and saw these things. And when I heard and saw them, I fell down to worship at the feet of the angel who showed them to me,*

*fell down - proskuneo to worship -- forbidden to men*

*Rev 22:9 but he said to me, “You must not do that! I am a fellow servant with you and your brothers the prophets, and with those who keep the words of this book. Worship God.” 10 And he said to me, “Do not seal up the words of the prophecy of this book, for the time is near.*

Matt 4:8 Again, the devil took Him to a very high mountain, and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world, and their glory; 9 and he said to Him, "All these things will I give You, if You fall down and worship me." 10 Then Jesus said to him, "Begone, Satan! For it is written, 'You shall worship the Lord your God, and serve Him only.'"

worship God!

Jesus was worshiped at His birth Mt 2.11

as He walked on the water; Mt 14.33

at his tomb Mt 28.9;

at his ascension Mt 28.17

We are to worship God continually.

Rom 12:1 I urge you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship.

*Rev 22:11-12 Let the evildoer still do evil,  
and the filthy still be filthy, and the righteous  
still do right, and the holy still be holy.” (12)*

*“Behold, I am coming soon, bringing my  
recompense with me, to repay each one for  
what he has done.*

Heb 9:27 it is appointed for men to die once  
and after this comes judgment,

2 Cor 5:10 For we must all appear before the  
judgment seat of Christ, that each one may be  
recompensed for his deeds in the body,  
according to what he has done, whether good  
or bad.

*Rev 22:13 I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end.” (14) Blessed are those who wash their robes, so that they may have the right to the tree of life and that they may enter the city by the gates. (15) Outside are the dogs and sorcerers and the sexually immoral and murderers and idolaters, and everyone who loves and practices falsehood.*

*Rev 22:17 The Spirit and the Bride say, "Come."  
And let the one who hears say, "Come." And let the

take the water of life without price.*

Matt 11:28 "Come to Me, all who are weary and

yoke upon you, and learn from Me, for I am gentle

*Rev 22:18 I warn everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: if anyone adds to them, God will add to him the plagues described in this book, (19) and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God will take away his share in the tree of life and in the holy city, which are described in this book. (20) He who testifies to these things says, “Surely I am coming soon.” Amen. Come, Lord Jesus! (21) The grace of the Lord Jesus be with all. Amen.*
